



Communication Milestones at 3-4 years

- Follows two-step directions (e.g. Get your shoes and bring them to mommy)
- Takes turns and plays cooperatively
- Frequently practices conversation skills by talking to self
- Expresses ideas and feelings
- Understands basic concepts and opposites (e.g. clean/dirty, fast/slow, night/day)
- Understands more spatial concepts (e.g. in front, behind, next to)
- Asks *where* and *why* questions frequently
- Uses 4-6 word sentences
- Speech is understood 90% of the time by unfamiliar listeners

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
