- Asks questions for information
- Uses language to resolve disputes with others
- Can explain *how-to* to listeners
- Speaks of imaginary words, such as "what if...," or "I hope..."
- Comprehends all question types, including *how many*
- Answers questions related to a story plot
- Understands basic math concepts, such as "more" and "less"
- Uses 6-8 word sentences
- · Speech is typically understood by strangers
